3:03	Hailey Blogg, Secretary: 11-20-25 Meeting Minutes vote (sent out via email) Pausing CEC highlight videos & 2026 ISLD Grant Award Update	(Secretary) record attendees, take minutes; special attention to action items & votes (all) vote to amend or approve minutes- motion, second, all in favor, anyone opposed? 1 st – Danielle, 2 nd – Jacob. All in favor. (Hailey) I am pausing the CEC highlight videos until further notice. I apologize if I haven't gotten to your sector. Currently, I do not have the capacity since I am working independently. Something will be done to highlight your sector, just not sure when. We were awarded the Idaho State Liquor Division (ISLD) Mini Grant which will fund one alcohol compliance check and shoulder tap operation and one LifeLoc device for the Alcohol Compliance Enforcement team. In addition, there is a new billboard advertisement on Locus Grove and Fairview causing concern, I have already brought it up with Code Enforcement, who ran it by legal. Due to how it is written there is nothing we can do, it is within the law.
3:05	Kendall: bylaw update, newsletter bulletin ideas/guest speakers (all) goal updates	(all) group discussion, share progress on individual prevention goals (Kendall) ISLD mini grant was one of Hailey's goals and it was awarded so kudos! Today I'd like to go over the by-laws. They are on the MADC website on the " About " page. I reviewed them, but I didn't see anything that needs to be addressed due to it being invalid. Does anyone have any comments, if they had a chance to review them? (Kati) I have 4 comments. First, under section that states the safety of working with youth, there may be a background check – do we need specifics on timeline? (Kendall) Let's open it for discussion, one of the reasons it's not more specific: it's unknown how long the background check will take. Because we don't have anyone working one-on-one with youth, I don't know that we have utilized it. (Anne) I would not include a timeline; it gives you more flexibility. (Kati) Second, under section 5, we should add in the Facebook page? It says email distribution. (Hailey) Also, it's not email distribution list, it's the newsletter now. Not sure if that matters. (Kendall) It's email related to keep it broad, the newsletter falls under email. (Danielle) Some people may not have Facebook. (Brenda) I don't have Facebook, so if communication was going to be the way, I wouldn't get it. (Kati) Third, Article V. for general

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		<p>meetings, adding in the annual service project? Should we have it locked into the by-laws? (Anne) Let’s leave it optional because then it doesn’t commit us to anything just in case we don’t have the time to do it one year. (Hailey) I think back to Covid, that is an extreme, but a lot of things were not able to happen during that time. (Anne) When you can’t fulfill the bylaws it’s a bad thing. Keeping them general helps. (Hailey) With a lot of these things we can delegate certain tasks to a sub-committee</p> <p>(Kendall) The MADC annual calendar guide lists event and program participation each year. The holiday service project will be placed on there as a reminder, and is a helpful guide if staff changes. (Kati) The last thing, terminology for substance abuse, can we change it “substance abuse and misuse?” (Hailey) The CADCA terminology is substance misuse, so if we ever apply for another big federal grant that is the format we’d have to follow. (Kendall) We follow best practice at the national level, keeping it in the bylaws is appropriate. Because we are not currently receiving federal funding, keeping it listed as misuse under the sector rep name tag is fine. If and when the time comes, we may need to align it. Any other changes anyone would like to comment on? (Jake) Nothing additional, I agree with the feedback discussed today. (Kendall) If everyone agrees I will fix the typo. If there are no other changes, we need a vote. (Anne) I move we approve the by-laws with the minor punctuation correction. (Danielle) Second (Hailey) All in favor. (Kendall) If you have guest speaker ideas or newsletter bulletins ideas please send them our way. We always want to make sure content is still relevant. Always checking newsletter analytics to help guide content selection. We want to see why people unsubscribe, if they do. (Hailey) I am always looking for newsletter content. Right now is our slow season, and with me doing the CADCA training, I am always looking for content to fill those gaps. If you have events or trainings to share, please send them my way. (Kati) The Unaltered State sent their survey data and it’s really good and it comes with resources. Maybe put together a bulletin using that. They are incentivizing parents and teens to work together. (Kendall) Now I’d like to touch base with goal updates, and see if anyone needs help with anything. (Anne) Attended NOWAC, but have not found anyone in the business sector to take this spot. Work in progress with the Kratom information. (Kendall) Thank you for researching Kratom. I was downtown with elected officials, and we were able to get that information to them quickly when it was requested. (Anne) I am receiving more feedback from citizens, but most is push-back. One wants more information. The FDA sheet is from 2017, the Mayo Clinic has some from 2024. Does anyone know of any Idaho specific? (Kendall) ODP has one. (Susie) New Camerena nominee coming from Parma. Is Robert still with MADC? (Kendall) Yes. (Susie) The video and poster contests are coming to an end, hoping there will be something to view soon. Have had some lodge members writing in about Kratom. (Kendall) We need to coordinate and get KiKi from City Hall.</p>
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		<p>Do you need him before the next MADC meeting? (Susie) I need the plaque sooner rather than later but let's wait until next month. (Kendall) I will get it over to the PD so it's here when you need it. (Kati) Upstream family focus that is going well. I modified my parent presentations that I have been doing virtually. We did one on screentime and had 28 people come. Parent presentations are going well. 98 people registered for the one next Monday. Youth diversion, our first presentation at the Bridge, had 5 parents and 2 teens attend. I did parent education and a cessation specialist met with the teens. The teens are continuing to attend. I plan on continuing with the Bridge - if they schedule it I'll be there. Advocating for government investments with prevention is an ongoing challenge. As a state employee, the most I can do is just to continue to educate. Like what Monte said, I can share but I cannot lobby. (Kendall) Starting programs at a grass roots level can be such a challenge, congrats to you for keeping it going and growing your programming. (Earl) I have been sending newsletter items to other private organizations, Cole Valley Christian, Compass Charter, St. Ignatius, Youth Program at Holy Apostles. We know at least one of them is getting it out. It's getting there, we are getting some info out to people we weren't previously reaching. My next request from those organizations is to get feedback. Maybe see if they can get us some additional schools to share education and resources with. (Jake) Volunteer at activities and find someone to fill this spot that operates in the church or faith realm. I have sent Hailey some people but they don't show up to the meetings. There are other networking opportunities I can go talk at. I am attending prayer faith collaborative every month called Mission 17, they have a large number of services that go to. I discuss what I do with the Mayor's office and how I work with MADC. If anyone would want to join me, let me know. (Kati) What day of the week? (Jake) 1st Wednesday every month. At St. Ignatius. March 4th at 7AM at St. Alphonsius off of Curtis. (Earl) Are you still working on finding a recovery day breakfast location? (Jake) Yes. (Hailey) A lot of the feedback we have received is people like the location at City Hall. So we can pause that for now. I have the room reserved for this year. (Yoonwa) Having the Hidden In Plain Sight (HIPS) trailer at parent orientation nights. Next admin training day is the 24th of March. 11-12:30 would be ideal. Will you be at the Career fair? (Hailey) Not at the career fair but I will be at parent night on April 14th. (Tiffany) I had a parent event with HIPS trailer and other community partners. The newsletter topics are going out in the high school newsletters. Lisa sends out great info regarding vaping to the middle schools. Toilet talks is also great info. We have some dates after Spring Break, with the MegaBrain at the Elementary Schools. We have identified schools, by violations. (Kati) The kids say that they have seen the brain before and that could be from other events or siblings which means they are talking about it. (Tiffany) We'll discuss what makes your brain healthy in the Elementary schools and the importance of doing those things. Drug Prevention Counselors</p>
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		<p>(DPCs) discuss the importance of healthy choices and have fun swag so the kids remember the middle school visit. (Danielle) Still serving on Region 4 Behavioral Health Board, working to bring in youth. I am changing jobs, more at the next meeting. I can help with Recovery Breakfast speakers again. (Hailey) I have a couple people I can reach out too but I will keep you posted. (Caylee) I wanted to increase my attendance at events which I think I've done, but I would love to attend more. Helped start the Mountain View Idaho Drug Free Youth program. I reached out to a middle school health teacher, I sent her Hailey and Kendall's contact information but we didn't hear back. (Hailey) It can be tricky to hear back sometimes. Leave it up to them if they want to reach out. Since you'll be around you can help with Youth Academy again this summer. (Kati) CATCH has a peer teaches peer model if you are interested maybe we could have you work with Lisa and get into the middle schools? (Caylee) I would love that.</p> <p>(Kendall) Maybe the Boys and Girls Club too. I looked at a few of our data sources. Some of the newsletter analytics showed a few bounce-backs that were bringing our rates down, but they are fixed now. Numbers have gone up for subscribers. HIPS usage: 2025, 9 events reached over 900 people. Parent engagement, partnership with Central District Health and Operation Parent handbooks, that resource was given out to 326 people. That is just for Q2. (Earl) What was the HIPS trailer stats? (Kendall) 11 total, 9 events in 2025 reaching 900 (Tiffany) Also, we send Parent Prevention Packing info home with students when they get a violation.</p>
