4:45	<p><b>Kendall: Legislative Wrap-up</b></p> <p><b>Position Update</b></p>	<p><b>Idaho Office of Drug Policy <a href="#">Bill Tracker</a>: End of Session Overview (Kendall)</b> Busy session, record number of bills introduced. 7 enacted into law, 1 concurrent resolution. Tracked drug prevention legislation throughout the session. No Kratom legislation made it all the way through. When I had early conversations with Tia, I told her you set your goal and if you don't hit that goal first session - it's still extremely valuable. We made good progress. Resolution in regard to a ballot initiative for marijuana. There are currently signature gatherers being paid with out-of-state funding. Put forth a resolution, gained momentum with the press. The resolution explains why is it a bad idea and it would put quality of life of Idaho in jeopardy. Shoutout to Senator Grow, he has consistently a prevention advocate. He spoke on the floor and raised the concerns. Monte Stiles had a role in that. In between sessions is really when we can do the groundwork. Letting them know what matters to you. <b>(Jake)</b> It was the Senator State Affairs not JFAC. <b>(Kendall)</b> Some of the bills that passed Hemp Regulation and Harms from Addictive Social Media.
